

Driver Safety



Changing lanes:

- Do not change lanes at railroad crossings or intersections.
- Know where your blind spots are and check them often.
- Know the conditions around you and move accordingly.
- Signal lane changes at least 100 feet in advance.
- Use the right lane for general highway cruising.
- Use center and left lanes for passing only.
- Keep mirrors clean and correctly adjusted.
- Avoid unnecessary lane changes.
- Change only one lane at a time.
- It is unsafe to pass on curves.
