



Driver Safety

Right turns:

- Signal at least 100 feet ahead of turning, unless another vehicle is about to enter the street before your turn. If so, wait until you pass them to signal.
- Check mirrors and blind spots.
- Be aware of bike riders and bike lanes—laws vary on whether it is legal to cross a bike lane or merge into the bike lane when turning.
- Yield to pedestrians.
- Begin turning slowly and edge around the corner, while assuring traffic is clear in all directions. Finish your turn in the correct lane.
- Cancel your turn signal if it does not turn off automatically.
