Driver Safety

Roundabouts:

- Slow down when approaching and driving through.
- Yield to pedestrians and bicyclists.
- Yield at entry to traffic already in the roundabout.
- Obey signs and pavement markings.
- Stay in your lane in multi-lane roundabouts—choose your lane before entering.
- Do not drive next to oversize vehicles.
- Do not stop in a roundabout.
- Signal your intention to exit.
